TITLE: 'Ethics and Nyāya in Indian Philosophy'

As it was decided in the departmental meeting 04.09.2019, the Department will arrange a special lecture program. So, accordingly on 26th September, 2019 the Department of philosophy organized a special lecture. **Prof. Ferdosh Islam, Associate Professor, Dinhata College**, was invited as the resource person to present his lecture on '*Ethics and Nyāya in Indian Philosophy*'. All teachers and many students attended the special lecture. It was unanimously decided that the principal will be the President of this lecture program.

At the outset of the program the president delivered his welcome speech and then the resource person started to present his lecture. The gist of his lecture is as follows. Though the ethics is a branch of the western philosophy and it can be treated as a distinct study, ethics in the context of Indian Philosophy is not so. In the context of Indian Philosophy ethics involve epistemology, metaphysics, logic, aesthetics etc. So, we cannot study or discuss the ethics in Indian Philosophy without these.

Question and answer session with the students at the end of the seminar. Students asked various questions about gender discrimination. Teachers also raise questions about gender discrimination. Prof. Islam satisfactorily answered all of the questions. Finally, Prof. Dipanjan Das, Coordinator of the programme, gave the Vote of thanks to all the participants and thus the special lecture programs ended successfully.
